Tesla

The Tesla Model 3, is a 5 seat, 210+mile electric to be sold for \$35,000 to \$42,000 and it's generating a lot of attention well over a year before delivery dates. This week the Chicago Tribune reported that enthusiastic customers went to Tesla showrooms on March 31st and put down \$1000 to reserve their Model 3 which is targeted for delivery in about a year. 115,000 were sold the first day, and when orders could be placed on-line the sales number rose to 276,000 world wide. Not too bad, it even surprised Elon Musk. For comparison, the Nissan Leaf has sold 211,000 in nearly 6 years since its launch in 2010. And when deliveries begin, remember the \$7,500 Federal tax credits begin to phase out after 200,000 units so the early bird catches the worm. If anyone in the club signed up please let me know!

American Hybrid History

So you think you know history, and you are more than familiar with many of the hybrid cars and EV s of today. Let's have a little quiz:

- 7. Toyota Prius was introduced in 1997 and it was available at all four Toyota Japan dealerships. When did US sales start?
- 8. US Prius (not other Toyota, just Prius) sales have what % of the hybrid market? (2013 data, the last available)
- 9. What was the first hybrid to be mass marketed in the US?
- 10. When did the federal government introduce tax deductions for purchasers of hybrid vehicles?
- 11. The Energy Policy Act of _____ started tax credits to hybrid vehicle purchasers

- The Woods Interurban of 1905 had a 2 cyl. Gas engine and an electric motor with batteries.
 Unfortunately, the charge over took 15 minutes, and the car was not a commercial success, despite several dozen being produced. (There were no 'production' lines in 1905)


